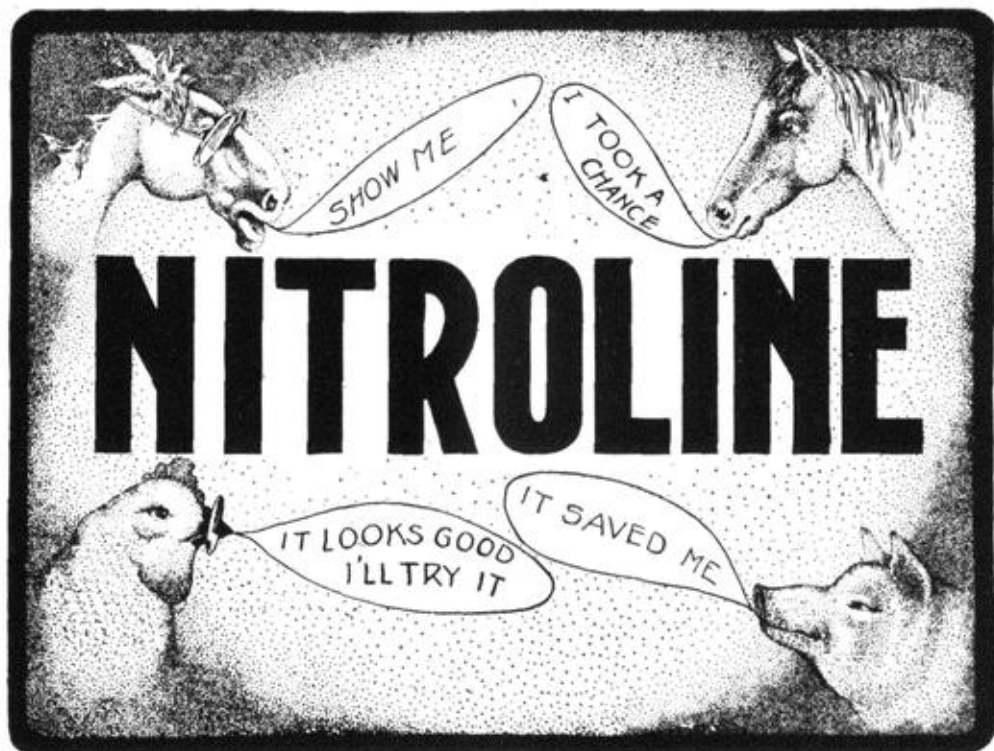

**TREATMENT FOR DISEASES AMONG HOGS.**

For cholera, blind staggers, scours, catarrh, diphtheria, worms, lice—8 tablespoonfuls of Nitroline is a dose for a grown hog; half above dose for pig or worms. Apply externally to destroy lice. Take good care of your hogs by giving them clean water to drink and wallow in. While they are well give them Nitroline mixed with feed or water, quantity according to number of hogs. TREATMENT OF DISEASES AMONG FOWLS.

For cholera, gapes, pip, diphtheritic roup, mites, lice, fleas and disease germs. Fowls too sick to eat pour down them tablespoonful of Nitroline, add half teacup to quart of meal dough for each dozen fowls once a day; feed to well and sick ones alike. Apply to the head for sore head, roup, very lightly to the little chicks; paint the perch with Nitroline; sprinkle in nest, on floor of hen house, in nest where little chicks roost. Put small quantity in drinking water occasionally; it will keep fowls healthy and make them lay and grow.
