PEARL MILLER

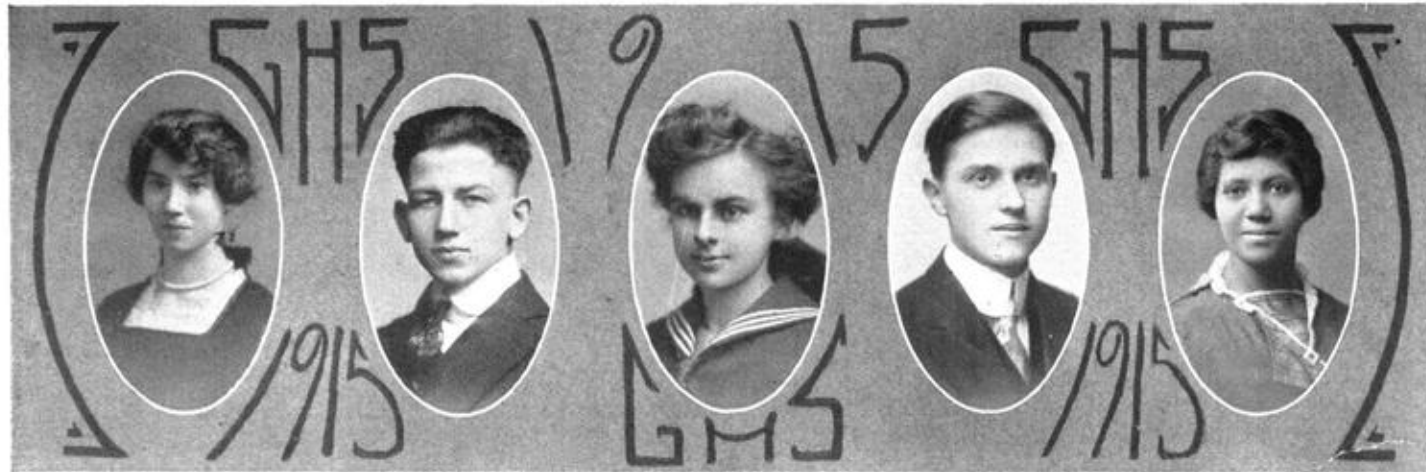
Pearl kept very quiet during all four years, but was right on hand when there was work to do or grades to get.
