Garfield's 1914 track team was one of the best in the state. She took part in three meets, coming out first in two of them and second in the third. Captain Smith, Conover, and Cooper represented the school in the dashes; Nitterhouse, Floyd, and Yatsko in the weights; McKee and Fortune in the pole vault; Shannon and Oxford in the long runs; Frey in the broad jump, high jump, hurdles, and 440 yard dash; Nitterhouse in the high jump, and Conover in the broad jump. Prospects for the 1915 team are just as bright, and with Capt. Conover at the helm, Garfield should enjoy another successful season.
