Onaway Camp Fire

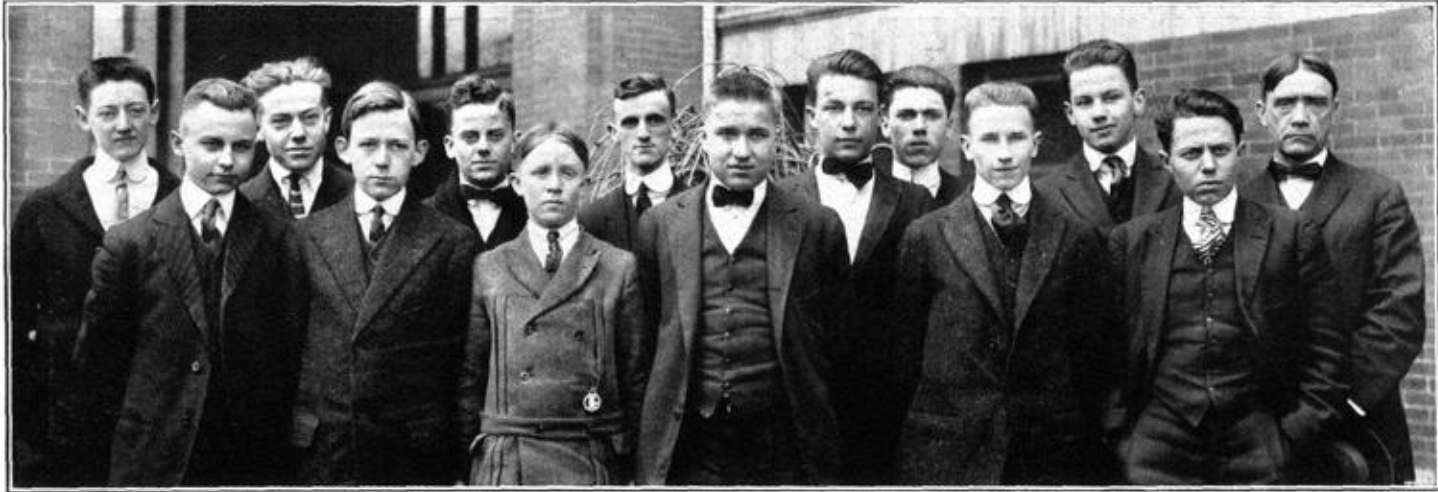
