ACT II.

Adelia: Der, die, oder das Mann?

Tinglius, looking anxiously toward entrance: Die Mann.

Adelia: Wrong, Tinglius. Think thou over this one. Der, die, oder das Kind?

Tinglius: Der Kind. Ting., deeply moved, with anxiety gazes toward entrance.

Adelia: Thou art again wrong. Der, die, oder das Hand?

Tinglius: Das Hand.

(*Rises in seat and looks imploringly toward door.*)

Adelia: Wrong again. Why this unseemly behavior, O Tinglius?

ENTER PENCETHENES, quietly. Goes toward desk and takes dictionary. Tinglius sighs with relief.

Pencethenes, meekly taking seat: Greetings, fair Adelia. I would consult thy word book.

Adelia: Thou art welcome, Pencethenes. Tinglius, let us continue. Der, die, oder das Tisch?

Tinglius glances toward Pencethenes. The ears of Pencethenes wiggle once.

Tinglius: Der Tisch.

Adelia: Right Tinglius. Thou hast well guessed. Try another. Der, die, oder das Madchen.

Tinglius glances toward Pencethenes. The ears of Pencethenes waggle thrice.

Tinglius: Das Madchen.

Adelia: Again, hast thou well guessed. Der, die, oder das Frau?

Tinglius glances toward Pencethenes. The ears of Pencethenes waggle twice. Tinglius answers correctly. Exam. continues thus to end.

Tinglius answers all questions correctly.
At end—

Adelia: Thy Exam. is over and thou hast passed with an high grade. Tinglius, thou art a wonder. Methought thou hadst not such intelligence. Let us retire and break the glad news to Bernardo.

[*Exit Ting. and Adelia.*]

Pencethenes, chuckling knowingly: Yea, Tinglius, thou art a wonder. [*Exit*]

ACT III.

SCENE: Srofius and Pencethenes sit on high board structure with backs to audience and witness contest between Lintonians and hosts from Garfield. Shouts are heard.

Srofius: Why this unseemly shouting? Ah, Tinglius maketh another touchdown. The battle is ours. We have won, Pencethenes. Hearest thou?

Pencethenes: Yea, we have won, but what care I? What honor do I, a mere citizen, get from the victory?

ENTER howling Garfield mob. Tinglius in grid-iron armor borne on shoulders of crowd.

The Dutchess, Hanko, Charlo, and others in crowd.

Charlo: Tinglius, thou hittest the battle-front of the Lintonians like a ton of brick.

Hanko: Brothers, how soundest this for my writing in the yellow sheet on the morrow?

Srofius: Again hast thou said.

Pencethenes: Let us hie to the Star villa and appease our hunger with a hamburger.

Srofius: Hamburger she is.

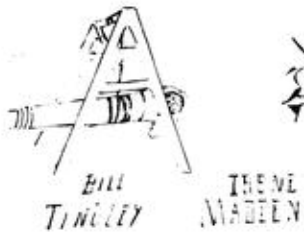
