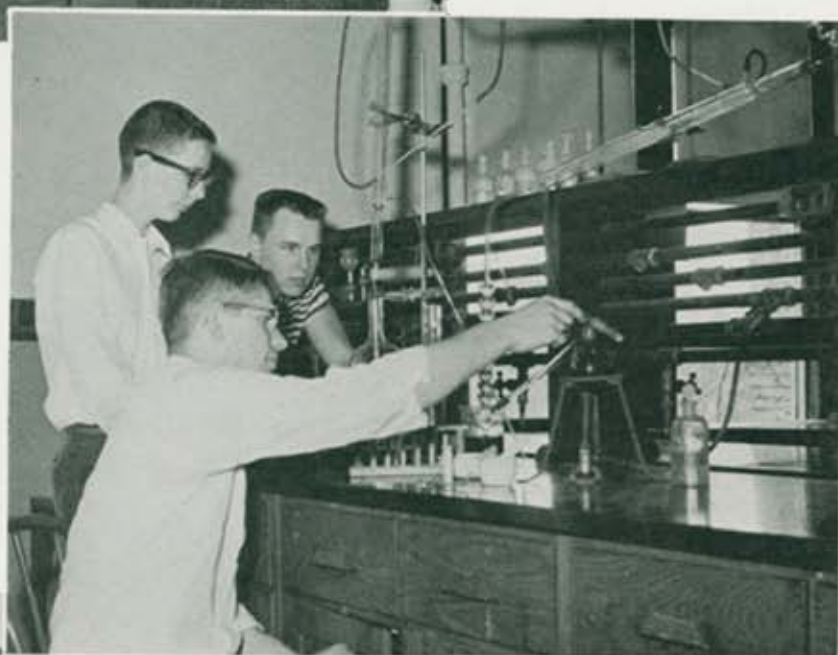
Some classes prepare us for higher education as we secure the proper background of fundamentals in all our work.
